Projects

P2011-0103, White, Town of Putnam.

Provided extensive review and comment concerning proposed 7-lot subdivision (4 lots jurisdictional) with shoreline on Lake George. Technical evaluation and issues includes stormwater management, erosion and sediment control, on-site wastewater treatment, grading and clearing limits, road construction, visibility and inter-Agency coordination with DEC and Lake George Park Commission. Involved Agency Staff: McSherry, Phillips, and LaLonde.

P2011-0095, Arbour, Town of Westport.

Provided technical comments associated with noise impacts at a proposed private airport in the Town of Westport. Involved Agency Staff: McSherry, Goroski, and LaLonde.

P2013-0140, George, Town of Franklin.

Attended variance hearing on September 11, 2013 for a proposed lateral expansion of a single family dwelling located within the 150 feet Recreational River Area setback.
