#### 5. Monthly Report of Enforcement Cases Settled:

Two enforcement cases were resolved by settlement agreements executed in **January 2017** as follows:

- E2016-0169, Kearney & Shepstone, (Chesterfield, Essex) Subdivision involving wetlands in Resource Management and within a highway critical environmental area in 1997. Settlement recognizes properties as lawful, requires Agency review of future jurisdictional activities, and requires filing in the county clerk's office. Settlement also allows for a proposed reconfiguration of lot lines without further approval.
- E2016-0164, Lawrence, (Corinth, Saratoga) Subdivision involving wetlands and creating a substandard-size parcel in Low Intensity Use in 2016. Settlement recognizes property as lawful, allocates a principal building right, requires Agency review of future jurisdictional activities, and requires filing in the county clerk's office.
