Lake George Riverview RV Park, LLC Lake George: Warren County Resource Management and Hamlet §809 of the Adirondack Park Agency Act and NYCRR Part 577

The project involves the expansion of a pre-existing campground on Resource Management lands from 94 sites to a total buildout of 167 sites. All sites will be designed to accommodate recreational vehicles. A bathhouse, pavilion, and game-room will be constructed. Access to the site will be off Route 9 at an existing access point, which will be modified to accommodate increased traffic. The campground

expansion will be served by municipal water supply, underground utilities and community on-site wastewater treatment systems.
