The action involves the installation of a 5 megawatt solar energy generating facility to be located partially within a previously authorized commerce park. The solar arrays will have a total footprint of 28 acres and the total area of disturbance will be 37 acres. Existing access from Commerce Drive to the project site will be improved with a stone base.
