5. Monthly Report of Executed Settlement Agreements:

Six enforcement cases were resolved by settlement agreements executed in April, May, and June 2021 as follows:

E2020-0023, Deems (Black Brook, Clinton County)

Subdivision undertaken in noncompliance with Permit 2002-0209 in 2018. Settlement recognizes property as lawful, allows for construction of an accessory structure and installation of a utility pole, requires a permit for any new principal building, and places restrictions on vegetation removal. The settlement must be filed in the County Clerk's Office.

E2021-0009, Sabatino (Bolton, Warren County)

Subdivision involving wetlands without a valid permit in 2014. Settlement recognizes property as lawful and allows for a prospective four-lot subdivision and construction of single family dwellings subject to conditions regarding wastewater treatment, accessory structures, lighting, docks, boathouses, building color, vegetation removal, and stormwater management. Settlement must be filed in the County Clerk's Office.

E2020-0097C, Hunt (Fine, St. Lawrence County)

Subdivision involving wetlands in 2019. Settlement recognizes property as lawful, requires an Agency permit for future subdivision or construction of a principal building,

requires Agency approval for any on-site wastewater treatment system, and requires filing in the County Clerk's Office.

E2021-0035, Kadric (Essex, Essex County)

Lot counting subdivision resulting from the construction of a single family dwelling in 2020. Settlement recognizes dwelling as lawful, allows for a two-lot subdivision of the property, allocates principal buildings, requires upgrading of the on-site wastewater treatment system and filing in the County Clerk's Office.

E2021-0033, Parker (Lake George, Warren County)

Subdivision involving wetlands in 2002. Settlement recognizes property as lawful, allows for construction of a dwelling and wastewater treatment system subject to conditions including implementation of erosion and sediment control measures, and requires filing in the County Clerk's office.

E2021-0062, Schoeninger (Ticonderoga, Essex County)

Subdivision involving wetlands in 2005. Settlement recognizes property as lawful, allows for construction of a dwelling, requires connection of the dwelling to municipal sewer, requires authorization of future structures, and filing in the County Clerk's Office.
