Lane Winney Town of Mayfield, Fulton County Low Intensity Use §809 of the Adirondack Park Agency Act

The action involves construction of a new campground located partially within the Adirondack Park. 123 sites are proposed in the Park, including 90 RV, 20 glamping, and 13 primitive sites. Related development within the Adirondack Park includes gated EMS access to/from Woods Hollow Road, three bathhouse facilities, office/registration building, maintenance/mechanical building, playground area, on-site water supply and wastewater systems, stormwater management, utilities, fencing and tree/shrub planting. Main public access to the campground, access to Great Sacandaga Lake and additional campground amenities are proposed outside the Adirondack Park and are not part of the APA review.
